

The 2026 Bucks-Mont Senior Golf League

The Senior Golf League launched our 8th season on April 6, 2026.

Here's a summary of our operations, which incorporate opinions of the 73% of our members who returned a survey in August 2025 and the decisions of the league officers who decided several of the close opinions.

- The league operates at two golf courses, giving members the choice of playing the full season at either one or both courses. 76% of our members said in our survey they would like to have this option.
- We play on Mondays at Twin Woods and Thursdays at Lederach Golf Club on Rt. 113 between Harleysville and Skippack. There will be a separate roster of players at each golf course.
- The league will operate from April 6 to September 21 at Twin Woods ... and April 9 to September 24 at Lederach.
- We'll continue operating a shotgun start at 4 p.m. at Twin Woods. The starting time at Lederach will be 5 p.m.
- The first 64 members who join or return to the league and sign up to play at Twin Woods will be assigned starting holes. Golfers who join the league after the first 64 openings are filled will play as substitutes for members who don't come to play any week.

- The first 32 members who choose to play at Lederach will be assigned starting holes. Golfers who choose to play at Lederach after the first 32 slots are filled will play as substitutes for those who don't come to play any week.
- There will be an awards banquet and the league's Annual Meeting for all members on Monday, September 28, 2026. The meal cost is included in the annual membership fee.
- The annual membership fee will remain at \$35, which can be paid at the first outing in April. Checks should be made payable to Bucks-Mont Senior Golf League.
- The 9-hole green fee at Twin Woods will be \$22, a riding cart fee will be \$8 and a pull cart will be \$3. The 9-hole rate at Lederach will be \$28, including a cart.
- Members who want to play 9 holes on Mondays at Twin Woods earlier than the league's 4 p.m. shotgun start may make tee times for no later than 2 p.m.
- Those who play on Thursdays at Lederach at the league's 5 p.m. shotgun start can play a "warm-up" 9 holes at 2 p.m. (a tee time is required). The green fee for all 18 holes will be \$40 for those who purchase the course's \$30 "Advantage Card".
- The starting-hole chart for April and May is posted on the league's website. We'll revise it for June-July and for August-September.
- Free handicaps will be provided to all golfers. Handicaps of previous members will be used for the first three 2026 rounds. New members must play three rounds in order to receive a league handicap.

- Golfers' scores are used to calculate a "handicap index", which is used to calculate a "course handicap" for each golf course. A "course handicap" is used to determine net scores for the weekly contests and other events.
- Members who have a USGA GHIN account have the option of using that 9-hole "handicap index" for league events and weekly prize contests. A GHIN account purchased at Twin Woods costs \$50.
- The league will use the lower of the league "handicap index" or GHIN "handicap index" when creating a member's "course handicap".
- All members who turn in scorecards will be eligible for a league championship at each golf course. Points will be awarded for the four low-net scores and the two on-course contests every week. The contests and the course ratings will be different for each course, so the point systems will be separated. The two golfers with the most points at the end of the season will be named champion at each course.
- We'll continue operating the optional weekly prize pool, where golfers can put in \$5 before play begins.
- There will be four low-net-score and two on-course contests every week, except on weeks of the Scrambles and on September 28. A separate prize pool will be operated at each course.
- There will be an after-golf social following golf every week at both courses and prizes will be awarded there. Beverages at the Twin woods social will cost \$2. Those playing at Lederach

can purchase food and beverages at the course's Leddy's Pub after they play.

- We'll operate Scrambles ONLY at Twin Woods on Mondays. Golfers who normally play at Lederach can play in the Scrambles at Twin Woods. There will be three Scrambles in 2026 – May, July and September. There will be a \$10 entry fee just for those who want to compete for prizes. Their foursomes will be created using the handicaps of the participants. Other members can play at no charge in foursomes created with a drawing of random numbers.
- Our annual Match-Play Tournament will be operated in August ONLY at Twin Woods. The entry fee will be \$10 and a minimum of 16 golfers will be needed for the tournament to operate. Members who play at Lederach on Thursdays would also play on tournament Mondays at Twin Woods until there is a winner.
- We will continue operating 50-50s at Twin Woods the first week of every month (\$5 per ticket).
- We'll continue updating the password-protected Members' Page of the website and continue sending text messages every week. The password is 26member.
