

Members' General Comments

- I like and look forward to Monday nights I think it is a well run league and fun to play.
- I don't think we should subsidize the scrambles. I would keep 1 on the schedule to see if we get enough members to participate. The tournament didn't seem to be a hit this year. 5 of the 16 were board members. I really like playing individual golf and the social after each round. I think you and some others do a great job at keeping the league stats, web site, and events.
- Perhaps grouping/pairing the players by similar handicaps as an option and randomize the starting holes more fully and more often (like monthly). It seems that our league prize system heavily favors high handicappers. Low and mid-handicappers have limited opportunities for win unless they were to play exceptionally well. These suggestions do imply adding some more competition if that is what the members want. Otherwise, the socialization is terrific.
- I have no criticisms on the league but I wish the course was in better condition. XI.e. grass on the fairways and keeping the rough cut. The greens are great.

It's not the policies, it's the participant behavior. I am not good but I learned from the beginning to play ready golf and not hold up play. Maybe it's because I don't turn in a scorecard (one day when I get better). One suggestion I have is to have a mechanism for people that know in advance if they are not planning to play (vacations, other planned events) to be visible....so you don't have say 2 people on 1 hole and 10 on another hole starting off. But maybe that is too complicated. Anyway, I very much enjoy the league and do plan on playing again next year.
- I feel the leagues policies are fair to all who sign up and pay the fees to play. I am not sure how it could be improved.
- I don't have any experience except for Twin woods. It all seems perfectly fine.
