

Tournament Details

- The tournament begins on July 7 and will operate in tandem with the normal weekly prize competitions.
- Members must play at least 6 rounds by June 30 to compete in the tournament.
- **This will be a single-elimination tournament.** Each week's winners will advance to the next week and be matched with another winner.
- League members who enter the tournament will be ranked and paired by their handicaps, similar to how the NCAA basketball brackets are formed (higher-seeded golfers will be matched with lower-seeded golfers). See the sample seeding bracket below.
- The golfer with the lower handicap will be assessed strokes, based on the difference in the pair's handicap. For example, if there is a two-stroke difference in the pair's handicaps, one stroke will be added to the score of the golfer with the lower handicap for each of the two most difficult holes on the course (see the sample scorecard below).
- Enter on the scorecard the score for each hole **AND** total each golfer's score, adding any additional strokes. See the sample scorecard below.
- Put an X in the "Won Hole?" box of the golfer who wins a hole.
- The golfer in each pair who wins the most holes will advance to the following week's round.
- Ties will be broken by playing at least one additional hole, using holes 4 and 5, until someone wins a hole. **No extra strokes are awarded during a playoff.**
- Eight golfers will win prize money if there are more than 16 participants (see the prize examples below).
- If a golfer is unable to play his/her scheduled round, that round can be played any day before the next scheduled round (**if the playing partner agrees**). Otherwise, the golfer will forfeit that round to his/her opponent and be eliminated from the tournament. A tee time must be made with the golf course to play any day other than when the league plays.

TOTAL ALL SCORES AND STROKES IN THE FAR-RIGHT COLUMN

If neither golfer wins the hole, leave the "Won Hole?" boxes empty.

Ties are broken by playing holes 4 and 5 until someone wins (no additional strokes).

Alternate Playing Date Instructions:

If you are unable to play on the scheduled tournament date/time, follow these instructions:

1. Contact your playing partner to arrange an alternate day/time to play.
1. Let Tom know you have scheduled an alternate date/time to play: teengleman@icloud.com
3. The alternate date/time must be before 1 p.m. on the next scheduled tournament date.
4. If you are unable to schedule an alternate date/time, you will have to forfeit that round.
5. When your round is complete, both golfers must sign this scorecard.
6. Take a photo of the scorecard and E-mail it to: teengleman@icloud.com
or bring it to the Gazebo at 4 p.m. on the scheduled tournament date.

Match-Play Tournament Prizes

Each participant provides a \$10 entry fee. If 20 or more golfers participate, prizes will be awarded to a Champion (35% of the total), the Runner-Up (25% of the total), 2 Semifinalists (15% of the total) and 4 Quarterfinalists (25% of the total).

Here's how a \$200 prize pool would be divided if there are 20 participants:

Champion -- \$70

Runner-Up -- \$50

2 Semifinalist Winners -- \$32 (\$16 each)

4 Quarterfinalist Winners -- \$48 (\$12 each)

Here's how a \$250 prize pool would be divided if there are 25 participants:

Champion -- \$90

Runner-Up -- \$62

2 Semifinalist Winners -- \$38 (\$19 each)

4 Quarterfinalist Winners -- \$60 (\$15 each)

Here's how a \$300 prize pool would be divided if there are 30 participants:

Champion -- \$105

Runner-Up -- \$75

2 Semifinalist Winners -- \$48 (\$24 each)

4 Quarterfinalist Winners -- \$72 (\$18 each)

If 17-19 golfers participate, the percentages will be 30% (Champion), 20% (Runner-Up), 15% (2 semifinalists-min. \$16 each), 30% (4 quarterfinalists-min. \$12 each).

If 12-16 golfers participate prizes will be awarded only to the two semifinalists, the finalist and the winner. The tournament will last only four weeks.
