

# Weekly League Procedures

- Arrive at Lederach no later than 4:30 p.m. (4 p.m. if you plan to purchase a bucket of balls for the driving range).
- Go to the Pro Shop and pay your \$28 green fee.
- Go to the league's table in Leddy's Pub, sign in to participate in the optional weekly prize contest (\$5). Our table and prize sign-in sheets will be to the left side of the main dining room.
- Get a golf cart and drive it to your car to get your clubs. It would be ideal to do that with another golfer who will be on your starting hole (two people per cart).
- Meet at the putting green no later than 4:45 p.m. and wait for final starting instructions, which may include a last-minute change in your starting hole. (We may be able to start earlier than 5 p.m., depending on where other golfers are on the course.)
- We'll stream out to our starting holes no later than 5 p.m. on the front 9 or back 9 on alternate weeks.
- Everyone must use the forward "white" tee areas throughout the golf course.
- The two on-course contests will be the two par-3 greens on the respective sides of the course. Write your name and distance on the league's placards if your ball is closer to the hole than any other league member who is playing ahead of you.
- We'll use your final 2025 handicap to determine your net score for your first three contest rounds. Handicaps for 2026 will be determined after you play three rounds.
- Maintaining a steady pace of play is important, so check out and follow these playing procedures:

- Please play “ready golf” so you can finish your round before 7:15 p.m. If nobody is in front of you on a fairway, go ahead and hit your ball. Your maximum number of strokes on any hole should be double par. If a group is waiting to tee off on the par 3 holes, wave them up so they can hit their drives before you finish putting.
- If your group is still playing at 7:15, finish that hole and put a bogey score on your scorecard for any unfinished holes.
- Turn in your scorecard AND order food in the Pub BEFORE you put your clubs away. There will be a basket for scorecards on the league’s table in Leddy’s Pub.
- We hope you’ll stay for the social, where we’ll award the weekly prizes for low-net scores and on-course contests. Order food and beverages at the Pub’s cash register.
- Six prizes will be awarded at the after-golf hangout. They are:
  - Those with the four low-net scores will win 25%, 20%, 15% and 10% of the pool and get 4, 3, 2 and 1 points. Low-net scores are the actual score minus the member’s Course Handicap.
  - The drives on the two Par 3 holes that are closest to the hole will win 15% of the prize money and 2 points for each drive. The Par 3 three holes on the front 9 are 5 and 7. The Par 3 holes on the back 9 are 14 and 16.
- In case of an emergency on the course, call 911.
